

Strategic Priorities for 2017/18, focusing on Outcomes for all groups of pupils

Leadership & Management

1) Ensure leaders forensically use all evidence available to them to demonstrate progress and pinpoint areas for development

2) Develop the role of middle leadership (subject leaders) to ensure further development of the curriculum (Science, computing and DT focus)

3) Governors' and senior leaders' development

Teaching, Learning and Assessment

4) Further develop effective teaching of basic skills and reasoning in maths

5) Further strengthen the quality of feedback to pupils, ensuring it makes an impact on their learning

6) Further strengthen staff knowledge of teaching spelling, grammar and reading

7) Priority 7: Review and strengthen the PSHE curriculum and the wider curriculum to ensure it challenges bullying, online safety, challenging stereotypes and prejudice and healthy lifestyles
