

# Strategic Priorities for 2016/17, focusing on Outcomes for all groups of pupils

## Leadership & Management

- 1) Ensure leaders forensically use all evidence available to them to demonstrate progress and pinpoint areas for development
- 2) Develop the role of middle leadership (subject leaders) to ensure further development of the whole curriculum
- 3) Agree and implement clear structures and processes so that governors hold senior leaders stringently to account for all aspects of the school's performance

## Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- 4) Further develop effective use of AfL to ensure 'real time' differentiation and intervention
- 5) Further strengthen the quality of feedback to pupils, ensuring it makes an impact on their learning
- 6) Further strengthen teacher subject knowledge of Maths and English to support effective differentiation and intervention

## Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare

- 7) Embed the new REACH system to further strengthen pupils' understanding of active learning
- 8) Systematically review and strengthen the effectiveness of SMSC provision
- 9) Increase awareness among parents and pupils of e safety and anti bullying work
